The Other Side

If the devil has led you down sin's road, you can return as the prodigal son did (Luke 15).

There can be victory in breaking bad habits. Many Christians have finally conquered smoking, bad language, procrastination, gossip, and alcohol addiction by saying, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13; 2 Corinthians 3:4-5). Jesus promised, "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in Him, bears much fruit, for without Me you can do nothing" (John 15:5). Our souls are too valuable to give up (Matthew 16:26). Love keeps on keeping on. If you have fallen, get up. God and this church are here to help.

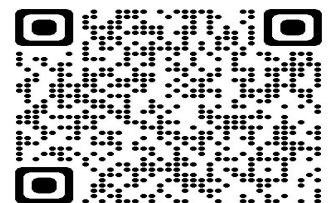

Our GriefShare class started on Saturday, August 17. It will be each Saturday from 10am-noon and will go through November 16. Any of our members who have struggled with loss are invited to participate. If you have friends who might benefit, please let them know about this class as well.

So many people in the world have experienced significant losses in their lives, so we're thankful to be able to offer this GriefShare Ministry. It is organized around a thirteen-week small-group program where participants meet together for around two hours each week and watch professionally-designed videos featuring professional grief counselors and also people who are grieving. These presentations are coupled with discussions that are designed to internalize what participants learn in the videos.
